INTERPRETATION ON THE INTERNATIONAL ONE METRE CLASS RULES

Interpretation requested by the IOMICA as follows:

Can an IOM **hull** be issued with a **certificate** with only a completed hull measurement form and without any rig/sail measurement form(s)?

Relevant rules

International One Metre Class Rule A.11.1 and
International One Metre Class Boat Measurement Form

Decision

The Boat Measurement Form has a space to indicate if rig measurement forms are attached. There is no specific requirement to attach any such forms.

An owner may seek registration and **certification** of a **hull** which is to be used with previously measured rig(s) and there is no need to re-measure and re-submit a Rig Measurement Form(s) if such form(s) has/have been previously accepted by the **Certification Authority**.

In this case it is only necessary for an Owner to request his or her **Certification Authority** to transfer existing Rig Measurement Form(s) to the new **boat** by amending the record of **boat** registration number.

In the case where rig(s) are to be used on more than one **boat**, it is only necessary for the Owner to request his or her **Certification Authority** to amend the existing Rig Measurement Form(s) to record all the **boat** registration numbers.

The measurer is always allowed to indicate in the measurer's comments box that rig/rigs are transferred from other **boat** for which the **certification authority** has the Rig Measurement Form(s) already.
