QUESTIONNAIRE TO BE COMPLETED BY A DIVISION MEMBER APPLYING TO HOST A WORLD OR CONTINENTAL CHAMPIONSHIP

Please answer **ALL** the questions as a minimum. You should also include any other relevant information to support your proposal to host the event, such as photos, video, tourist publicity and background information on the host club.

A) GENERAL

1. Is this application for a World or Continental Championship?
2. Which class or classes are to be sailed?
3. What are the proposed dates of the championship?
4. Are there any other major events planned in the locality, which could make accomodation and flights difficult to obtain?
5. What is the exact location of the proposed venue?

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B) SAILING SITE

1. What is the size, shape, and geographic location of the sailing water? Please answer this question on a separate sheet of paper, marking in the prevailing wind and the positions and height of any obstructions on the edge of the water. You could also enclose photos and/or a video.
2. What wind and weather conditions can be expected during the proposed championship?
Separate sheet please.
3. What is the minimum depth of water for the sailing area?
4. Is the water still, tidal (rise & fall), and/or is there a current running through?
5. Is the water clear of weed growth at all times,
6. If not will it be clear of weed during the period of the event?
7. Are the launch areas dry so that skippers are not require to wade or paddle?
8. Will you be able to site the control position so that the sun is behind the competitors?
9. Will you be able to set an Olympic course with Port hand rounding regardless of the wind direction with the course marks easily identifiable from the Control Area?
10. Will the course marks be of a size between 300-600mm diameter and a max of 300mm above the water?

C) RADIO FREQUENCIES

1. What radio frequency bands will be available for competitors, are there any restrictions?

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D) SAILING SITE FACILITIES

1. Boat storage on site.
2. Daytime security Guard(s) for boats and equipment.
3. Night-time security Guard(s) for boats and equipment.

4. Interpreters.
5. Male and Female lavatories on site.
6. Food and drinks cafeteria.
7. Shelter for bad weather (either rain or strong sun).
8. Car Parking (free?).
9. Caravan Parking (free?).
10. Camping facilities (free?).
11. Cabins, tents or rooms for the Race Committee & Jury.
12. Battery charging facilities, What Voltage(s)?
13. Repair facilities for yachts and radios.
14. At least one powered craft for mark laying.
15. At least one powered craft for boat rescue.
16. Course marks and ground tackle that can be repositioned quickly.
17. Public address system that can be heard all over the site.
18. Tape recorder for start tape and another for recording the finishing order.
19. Radio Frequency monitor.
20. Computer for scoring.
21. Race notice board, course board, fleet board and score board.
22. Measuring tank (if applicable), scales and under cover facilities for measuring boats

 - d) Outings, Sightseeing for non-competitors?
 - e) Any other social functions?

F) MANAGEMENT and FINANCE

1. Will you be able to obtain financial assistance from:

 - b) Your Local Authority?
 - c) Private or business sponsorship?
2. Are you confident that your Division Member and/or organising club has the necessary financial backing to host the event?
3. Do you agree to pay ISAF RSD the relevant levy from the race entry fees?
4. Do you agree to conform to the rules of ISAF RSD and the Notice of Race and Sailing Instructions agreed with the RSD Chairman of Racing Rules Committee?
