Technical Chairperson's report

ISAF have expressed to wish to see our rules rewritten in closed format which we do not see as being of any benefit to the classes concerned. In discussing this, it has become apparent that, along with the racing rules appendix, we could make a good case for a similar appendix in the ERS or even opt out of using it at all, since the use of ERS terminology and definitions is not mandatory.

The Technical Committee has been considering the matter of how boats are measured in the light of the need to rewrite class rule. Further research will be necessary to arrive at simple, efficient and workable methods that can be carried out by relatively untrained sailors.

Latterly John Simpson has stepped in to act as Chairman in my absence and both he and the other members of the Committee have been both active and conscientious in dealing with matters arising.
