To decide the Maximum Draught Restriction (MDR) for Marblehead and Ten Rater Classes

After much discussion concerning whether it was: -

- ◆ the duty of the PC to decide
- ◆ a class issue
- ◆ if there were an Owners Association then the owners would decide

Two proposals were put forward: -

1. **That the approved gauge, with a cut out for maximum draught of 700mm be adopted for all RSD classes.**

Seconded by Ken Roberts

2. **That a voting paper be sent to all owners of registered/certificated International Marbleheads, allowing them to prioritise from a range between 600 - 700mm and using a single transferable vote the depth restriction the majority wanted would be established.**

Proposed by Keith Skipper
Seconded by Graham Bantock

Proposal 1 achieved a majority with votes from JC KR NW ZG BM.
